1 Peter 5:7 (NKJV)

Casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

Psalms 55:22 (NKJV)

Cast your burdens/ cares on the LORD, And He shall sustain you; He shall never permit the righteous to be moved.

John 14:6 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 14:6 (AMP)

Jesus said to him, “I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (ERV)

The only temptations that you have are the same temptations that all people have. But you can trust God.

He will not let you be tempted more than you can bear.

But when you are tempted, God will also give you a way to escape that temptation. Then you will be able to endure it.

1 Corinthians 10:13 (NKJV)

No temptation has overtaken you except such as is common to man; but God *is* faithful, who will not allow you to be tempted beyond what you are able, but with the temptation will also make the way of escape, that you may be able to bear *it*.

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NLT)

For we live by believing and not by seeing.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)

For we walk by faith, not by sight.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (AMP)

for we walk by faith, not by sight [living our lives in a manner consistent with our confident belief in God's promises]

James 4:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil & he will flee from you.

⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *you* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *you* double-minded.

James 4:7-8 (AMP)

⁷ So submit to [the authority of] God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him] and he will flee from you. ⁸ Come close to God

[with a contrite heart] and He will come close to you. Wash your hands, *you* sinners; and purify your [unfaithful] hearts, *you* double-minded [people].

John 3:16 (NLT)

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16 (NKJV)

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

Hebrews 11:1 (NKJV)

Now faith is the substance of things hoped for,
the evidence of things not seen.

Hebrews 11:6 (NKJV)

But without faith *it is* impossible to please *Him*,
for he who comes to God must believe that He is,
and *that* He is a rewarder of those who diligently
seek Him.

John 16:33 (ERV)

I have told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have troubles. But be brave! I have defeated the world!”

John 16:33 (NKJV)

³³ These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; ⁶ In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (AMP)

⁵ Trust in *and* rely confidently on the LORD with all your heart And do not rely on your own insight or understanding. ⁶ In all your ways know *and* acknowledge *and* recognize Him, And He will make your paths straight *and* smooth [removing obstacles that block your way].

Psalms 37:23 (NKJV)

The steps of a *good* man are ordered by the LORD, And He delights in his way.

Psalms 37:23 (AMP)

The steps of a [good and righteous] man are directed *and* established by the LORD,
And He delights in his way [and blesses his path].

Proverbs 24:16 (NKJV)

For a righteous *man* may fall seven times And
rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity.

Proverbs 24:16 (AMP)

For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises
again, But the wicked stumble in *time*
of disaster *and* collapse.

Proverbs 4:18-19 (NKJV)

18 But the path of the just *is* like the shining sun,
That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.

19 The way of the wicked *is* like darkness;
They do not know what makes them stumble.

Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)

⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

John 10:10 (AMP)

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Psalm 23 (KJV)

1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.
