Isaiah 40:31 (Amp)

**But those who wait for the LORD [who expect, look
for, and hope in Him] Will gain new strength and
renew their power; They will lift up their wings
[and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising**

John 14:6 (NKJV)

Jesus said to him, “I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me.

John 14:6 (AMP)

Jesus said to him, “I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 10:10 (AMP)

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Hebrews 13:5-6 (NKJV)

⁵ Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “**I will never leave you nor forsake you.**”

⁶ So we may boldly say: “**The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?**”

Romans 12:2 (NLT)

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Psalm 27:14 (NLT)

Wait patiently for the LORD. Be brave and courageous. Yes, wait patiently for the LORD.

Psalm 27:14 (NKJV)

Wait on the LORD; Be of good courage, And He shall strengthen your heart; Wait, I say, on the LORD!

Psalms 37:7 (NLT)

Be still in the presence of the LORD, and wait patiently for him to act. Don't worry about evil people who prosper or fret about their wicked schemes.

Psalms 37:7 (NKJV)

Rest in the LORD, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.

James 1:2-4 (NKJV)

- 2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials,
- 3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience.
- 4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

Galatians 5:22-23 (NKJV)

22 But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace,

Philippians 4:13 (AMP)

¹³ I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Ephesians 5:20 (NKJV)

Giving thanks always for all things to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ,

Ephesians 5:20 (AMP)

Always giving thanks to God the Father for all things, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

Psalms 100 (KJV)

- 1** Make a joyful noise unto the LORD, all ye lands.
- 2** Serve the LORD with gladness: come before his presence with singing.
- 3** Know ye that the LORD he is God: it is he that hath made us, and not we ourselves; we are his people, and the sheep of his pasture.
- 4** Enter into his gates with thanksgiving, and into his courts with praise: be thankful unto him, and bless his name.
- 5** For the LORD is good; his mercy is everlasting; and his truth

Matthew 6:33-34 (NIV)

33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

John 3:16 (NLT)

John 3:16 (NKJV)

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

1 Peter 5:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

⁸ Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour

1 Peter 5:7-8 (AMP)

⁷ casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]. ⁸ Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert *and* cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

Philippians 4:6 (NLT)

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.

Philippians 4:6 (NKJV)

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

John 16:33 (ERV)

I have told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have troubles. But be brave! I have defeated the world!”

John 16:33 (NKJV)

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

1 John 4:4 (NKJV)

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:4 (AMP)

Little children (believers, dear ones), you are of God *and* you belong to Him and have [already] overcome them [the agents of the antichrist]; because He who is in you is greater than he (Satan) who is in the world [of sinful mankind].

James 3:8 (NKJV)

But no man can tame the tongue. *It is* an unruly evil, full of deadly poison.

James 3:8 (AMP)

But no one can tame the *human* tongue; it is a restless evil [undisciplined, unstable], full of deadly poison.

Ephesians 4:26-27 (ERV)

²⁶ When you are angry, don't let that anger make you sin, and don't stay angry all day.

²⁷ Don't give the devil a way to defeat you.

Ephesians 4:26-27 (NKJV)

²⁶ Be angry, and do not sin: do not let the sun go down on your wrath,

²⁷ Nor give place to the devil.

Psalm 51:10 (NKJV)

Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Psalm 51:10 (AMP)

Create in me a clean heart, O God, And renew a right *and* steadfast spirit within me.

Eph 5:1 (AMP) Be Imitators of God

Therefore become imitators of God
[copy Him and follow His example],
as well-beloved children [imitate their father];

Isaiah 40:31 (NKJV)

**But those who wait on the LORD Shall
renew their strength; They shall mount up with
wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary,
They shall walk and not faint.**

Isaiah 40:31 (Amp)

**But those who wait for the LORD [who expect, look
for, and hope in Him] Will gain new strength and
renew their power; They will lift up their wings
