Matthew 5:14-16 (NKJV)

¹⁴ “You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. ¹⁵ Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all *who are* in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Matthew 5:14-16 (AMP)

¹⁴ “You are the light of [Christ to] the world. A city set on a hill cannot be hidden; ¹⁵ nor does *anyone* light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. ¹⁶ Let your light shine before men in such a way that they may see your good deeds *and* moral excellence, and [recognize and honor and] glorify your Father who is in heaven.

John 8:12 (NKJV)

Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, “I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.”

John 8:12 (AMP)

Once more Jesus addressed the crowd. He said, “I am the Light of the world. He who follows Me will not walk in the darkness, but will have the Light of life.”

2 Corinthians 4:6 (NKJV)

For it is the God who commanded light to shine out of darkness, who has shone in our hearts to *give* the light of the knowledge of the glory of God in the face of Jesus Christ.

2 Corinthians 4:6 (AMP)

For God, who said, “Let light shine out of darkness,” is the One who has shone in our hearts to give us the Light of the knowledge of the glory *and* majesty of God [clearly revealed] in the face of Christ.

Ephesians 5:8 (ERV)

In the past you were full of darkness, but now you are full of light in the Lord. So live like children who belong to the light.

Ephesians 5:8 (NKJV) “Walk in Light”

For you were once darkness, but now *you are* light in the Lord. Walk as children of light.

1 Peter 2:9 (NLT)

But you are not like that, for you are a chosen people. You are royal priests, a holy nation, God's very own possession. As a result, you can show others the goodness of God, for he called you out of the darkness into his wonderful light.

1 Peter 2:9 (NKJV)

But you *are* a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people, that you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light;

Psalm 119:105 (ERV)

Your word is like a lamp that guides my steps,
a light that shows the path I should take.

Psalm 119:105 (NKJV)

Your word *is* a lamp to my feet And a light to my
path.

Isaiah 60:1 (NKJV)

Arise, shine; For your light has come! And the glory of the LORD is risen upon you.

Isaiah 60:1 (AMP)

“Arise [from spiritual depression to a new life], shine [be radiant with the glory *and* brilliance of the LORD]; for your light has come, And the glory *and* brilliance of the LORD has risen upon you

John 1:5 (NLT)

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness can never extinguish it.

John 1:5 (NKJV)

And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.

John 1:5 (AMP)

The Light shines on in the darkness, and the darkness did not understand it *or* overpower it *or* appropriate it *or* absorb it [and is unreceptive to it].

Psalm 27:1 (KJV)

The LORD is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

Mark 16:15 (NKJV)

And He said to them, “Go into all the world and preach the gospel to every creature.

1. Go Bring My Light into all the dark & sinful world.
2. Go Light your World for Him!
3. Where He sends you, where you are,
(where you live, where you work, where you shop,
your family, friends & enemies)

Isaiah 6:8 (NLT)

Then I heard the Lord asking, “Whom should I send as a messenger to this people? Who will go for us?” I said, **“Here I am. Send me.”**

Isaiah 6:8 (KJV)

Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, **Here am I; send me.**

Isaiah 40:31 (NKJV)

But those who wait on the LORD Shall renew their strength; They shall mount up with wings like eagles, They shall run and not be weary, They shall walk and not faint.

Isaiah 40:31 (AMP)

But those who wait for the LORD [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] Will gain new strength *and* renew their power; They will lift up their wings [and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising toward the sun]; They will run and not become weary, They will walk and not grow tired.

Matthew 6:33-34 (NIV)

33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Ephesians 5:1-2 (AMP) “Be Imitators of God”

¹Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father];

²and walk *continually* in love [that is, value one another—practice empathy and compassion, unselfishly seeking the best for others], just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God [slain for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.

Proverbs 18:21 (ERV)

The tongue can speak words that bring life or death. Those who love to talk must be ready to accept what it brings.

Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 18:21 (AMP)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue,
And those who love it *and* indulge it will eat its fruit *and* bear the consequences of their words.

Jeremiah 29:11 (NIV)

For I know the plans I have for you,” declares the LORD, “plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.

Proverbs 16:3 (NKJV)

Commit your works to the LORD, And your thoughts will be established.

Proverbs 16:3 (AMP)

Commit your works to the LORD [submit & trust them to Him], And your plans will succeed [if you respond to His will & guidance].

Mark 12:30 (NKJV)

And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This *is* the first commandment.

Colossians 3:23-24 (NKJV)

²³ And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

Hebrews 6:10 (NKJV)

For God *is* not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.

Revelation 3:16 (NLT)

But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!

Revelation 3:16 (NKJV)

So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

Deuteronomy 4:24 (NKJV)

For the LORD your God *is* a consuming fire, a jealous God.

Deuteronomy 4:24 (AMP)

For the LORD your God is a consuming fire; He is a jealous (impassioned) God [demanding what is rightfully and uniquely His].

Acts 1:8 (NKJV)

But you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be witnesses to Me in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the end of the earth.”

Acts 1:8 (AMP)

But you will receive power *and* ability when the Holy Spirit comes upon you; and you will be My witnesses [to tell people about Me] both in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and Samaria, and even to the ends of the earth.”

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].
