1 John 5:4 (NKJV)

For whatever is born of God overcomes the world.
And this is the victory that has overcome the world
our faith.

1 John 5:4 (AMP)

For everyone born of God is
victorious *and* overcomes the world; and this is the
victory that has conquered *and* overcome the world
—our [continuing, persistent] faith [in Jesus the Son
of God].

1 Corinthians 15:57 (NKJV)

But thanks *be* to God, who gives us the Victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.

1 Corinthians 15:57 (AMP)

But thanks be to God, who gives us the Victory [as conquerors] through our Lord Jesus Christ.

Matthew 6:33-34 (NIV)

33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NLT)

For we live by believing and not by seeing.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV)

For we walk by faith, not by sight.

2 Corinthians 5:7 (AMP)

for we walk by faith, not by sight
[living our lives in a manner consistent with
our confident belief in God's promises]

Philippians 4:6 (NLT)

Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done.

Philippians 4:6 (NKJV)

Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

1 Peter 5:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

⁸ Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour

1 Peter 5:7-8 (AMP)

⁷ casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]. ⁸ Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert *and* cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.(consume, demolish, dispose of)

Philippians 4:13 (NKJV)

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Philippians 4:13 (AMP)

¹³ I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who Strengthens *and* Empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Psalms 118:24 (NKJV)

This *is* the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.

Psalms 118:24 (AMP)

This [day in which God has saved me] is the day which the LORD has made; Let us rejoice and be glad in it.

**This is the day the LORD has made &
Victory Is Mine Daily!**

1 John 1:9-10 (NKJV)

If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us *our* sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.

¹⁰ If we say that we have not sinned, we make Him a liar, and His word is not in us.

**Jesus Paid it ALL,
ALL To Him I Owe!**

John 8:36 (NKJV)

Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed.

John 8:36 (AMP)

So if the Son makes you free, then you are unquestionably free.

Proverbs 18:21 (MSG)

Words kill, Words give life; they are either poison or fruit—you choose. You plant your garden & you reap what you sow/plant.

Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 18:21 (AMP)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue,
And those who love it *and* indulge it will eat its fruit *and* bear the consequences of their words

John 8:32 (NKJV)

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free.

John 8:32 (AMP)

And you will know the truth [regarding salvation], and the truth will set you free [from the penalty of sin].

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

Acts 2:41 (AMP)

So then, those who accepted his message were baptized; and on that day about 3,000 souls were added [to the body of believers].

Acts 4:4 (AMP)

But many of those who heard the message [of salvation] believed [in Jesus and accepted Him as the Christ]. And the number of the men came to be about 5,000.

1 Timothy 6:12 (NKJV)

Fight the good fight of faith, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

1 Timothy 6:12 (AMP)

Fight the good fight of the faith [in the conflict with evil]; take hold of the eternal life to which you were called, and [for which] you made the good confession [of faith] in the presence of many witnesses.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Philippians 4:8 (NLT)

And now, dear brothers and sisters, one final thing. Fix your thoughts on what is true, and honorable, and right, and pure, and lovely, and admirable. Think about things that are excellent and worthy of praise.

Philippians 4:8 (NKJV)

Finally, brethren, whatever things are true, whatever things *are* noble, whatever things *are* just, whatever things *are* pure, whatever things *are* lovely, whatever things *are* of good report, if *there is* any virtue and if *there is* anything praiseworthy-meditate on these things.

Mark 16:19 (NKJV)

So then, after the Lord had spoken to them, He was received up into heaven, and sat down at the right hand of God.

Romans 8:34 (NKJV)

Who *is* he who condemns? *It is* Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.

Right hand of God! Place of Honor &

And He sits!

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

John 10:10 (AMP)

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Ephesians 4:27 (KJV)

Neither give place to the devil.

Ephesians 4:27 (AMP)

And do not give the devil an opportunity
[to lead you into sin by holding a grudge, or
nurturing anger, or harboring resentment, or
cultivating bitterness].

1 John 4:4 (NKJV)

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.

1 John 4:4 (AMP)

Little children (believers, dear ones), you are of God *and* you belong to Him and have [already] overcome them [the agents of the antichrist]; because He who is in you is greater than he (Satan) who is in the world [of sinful mankind].

John 16:33 ERV

I have told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have troubles. But be brave! I have defeated the world!”

John 16:33 (NKJV)

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world.”

John 16:33 (Expanded Bible)

I told you these things so that you can have peace in me. In this world you will have trouble [persecution; suffering], but be brave [take courage/heart]! I have defeated [victory over; conquered; overcome] the world.

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2 Corinthians 5:17 (ERV)

When anyone is in Christ, it is a whole new world.
The old things are gone; suddenly, everything is new!

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Colossians 3:23-24 (NKJV)

²³ And whatever you do, do it heartily, as to the Lord and not to men, ²⁴ knowing that from the Lord you will receive the reward of the inheritance; for you serve the Lord Christ.

Hebrews 6:10 (NKJV)

For God *is* not unjust to forget your work and labor of love which you have shown toward His name, *in that* you have ministered to the saints, and do minister.
