2 Corinthians 5:7 (NKJV) For we walk by faith, not by sight.

Romans 10:17 (NKJV)

So then faith comes by hearing, and hearing by the word of God.

Psalm 100:2 (NKJV)

Psalm 100:2 (AMP)

Exodus 7:16 (NKJV)

James 1:17 (ERV)

Psalm 139:13 (NKJV)

Psalm 139:13 (AMP)

For You formed my innermost parts; You knit me [together] in my mother's womb.

Psalm 100:4 (NKJV)

Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, *And* into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, *and* bless His name.

Psalm 100:4 (AMP)

Enter His gates with a song of thanksgiving And His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, bless *and* praise His name.

Romans 12:1 (NKJV)

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you <u>present your bodies a living sacrifice</u>, holy, acceptable to God, *which is* your reasonable service.

Romans 12:1 (AMP)

Therefore I urge you, brothers and sisters, by the mercies of God, to present your bodies [dedicating all of yourselves, set apart] as a living sacrifice, holy and well-pleasing to God, which is your rational (logical, intelligent) act of worship.

Psalm 100:5 (NKJV)

For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, And His truth endures to all generations.

Psalm 100:5 (AMP)

For the LORD is good; His mercy and lovingkindness are everlasting, His faithfulness [endures] to all generations.
