Proverbs 3:5-6 (AMP)

5 Trust in *and* rely confidently on the LORD with all your heart
And do not rely on your own insight *or* understanding.
6 In all your ways know *and* acknowledge *and* recognize Him,
And He will make your paths straight *and* smooth
[removing obstacles that block your way].

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)

7 For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

Matthew 11:28-30 (ERV)

28 “Come to me all of you who are tired from the heavy burden you have been forced to carry. I will give you rest. **29** Accept my teaching. Learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. James 1:8 (NLT)

Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do.

James 1:8 (NKJV)

He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

Proverbs 3:30-32 (NLT)
