Romans 12:2 (NLT)

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Hebrews 10:25 (NLT)

And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but Encourage one another, especially now that the day of His return is drawing near.

Hebrews 10:25 (NKJV)

Not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but Exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.
