⁷ casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]. ⁸ Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert *and* cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

Matthew 11:28-30 (ERV)

28 “Come to me all of you who are tired from the heavy burden you have been forced to carry. I will give you rest.

29 Accept my teaching. Learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will be able to get some rest.

30 Yes, the teaching that I ask you to accept is easy. The load I give you to carry is light.”

2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

James 4:7-8 (ERV)

⁷ So give yourselves to God. Stand against the devil, and he will run away from you.

⁸ Come Near/Close to God and he will come Near/Close to you. You are sinners, so clean sin out of your lives. You are trying to follow God and the world at the same time. Make your thinking pure.
