Isaiah 43:21 (ERV)

I made them, and they will sing songs of praise to me.

Isaiah 43:21 (GNT)

They are the people I made for myself, and they will sing my praises!

Isaiah 43:21 (NKJV)

This people I have formed for Myself; They shall declare My praise.

John 4:23-24 (ERV)

²³ But the time is coming when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth. In fact, that time is now here. And these are the kind of people the Father wants to be his worshipers. ²⁴ God is spirit. So the people who worship him must worship in spirit and truth.

John 4:23-24 (NKJV)

²³ But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. ²⁴ God *is* Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.

And you will seek Me and find *Me*, when you search for Me with all your heart.

Expressions Of Worship

1. Lifting hands (Psalm 141:2 NKJV)

Let my prayer be set before You as incense, The lifting up of my hands as the evening sacrifice.

2. Clapping hands (Psalm 47:1 NKJV)

Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! Shout to God with the voice of triumph!

3. Bowing down (Psalm 95:6 NKJV)

Oh come, let us worship and bow down; Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

4. Kneeling (Psalm 95:6 NKJV)

5. Dancing (Psalm 149:3 NKJV)

Let them praise His name with the dance; Let them sing

1 Cor. 6:19-20 (NKJV)

¹⁹ Or do you not know that your body is the temple of the Holy Spirit *who is* in you, whom you have from God, and you are not your own? ²⁰ For you were bought at a price; therefore glorify God in your body and in your spirit, which are God's.

1 Cor. 6:19-20 (AMP)

¹⁹ Do you not know that your body is a temple of the Holy Spirit who is within you, whom you have [received as a gift] from God, and that you are not your own [property]? ²⁰ You were bought with a price [you were actually purchased with the precious blood of Jesus and made His own]. So then, honor *and* glorify God with your body.

Revelation 3:20 (NKJV)

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

Revelation 3:20 (AMP)

Behold, I stand at the door [of the church] and *continually* knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with him (restore him), and he with Me.

Hebrews 4:16 (ERV)

With Jesus as our High Priest, we can feel free to come before God's throne where there is grace. There we receive mercy and kindness to help us when we need it.

Hebrews 4:16 (NKJV)

Let us therefore come boldly to the throne of grace, that we may obtain mercy and find grace to help in time of need.

Isaiah 61:3 (NKJV)

To console those who mourn in Zion,
To give them beauty for ashes,
The oil of joy for mourning,
The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness;
That they may be called trees of righteousness,
The planting of the LORD, that He may be glorified.”

Psalm 34:1 (ERV)

I will praise the LORD at all times. I will never stop singing his praises.

Psalm 34:1(NKJV)

I will bless the LORD at all times; His praise shall continually *be* in my mouth.

Psalm 34:3 (ERV)

Praise the LORD with me. Let us honor his name.

Psalm 34:3 (NKJV)

Oh, magnify the LORD with me, And let us exalt
His name together.

Psalm 63:3-4 (NKJV)

³ Because Your lovingkindness *is* better than life, My lips shall praise You.

⁴ Thus I will bless You while I live; I will lift up my hands in Your name.

Psalm 95:6 (NKJV)

Oh come, let us worship and bow down;
Let us kneel before the LORD our Maker.

2 Samuel 6:14 (NKJV)

Then David danced before the LORD with all *his* might; and David *was* wearing a linen ephod.

2 Samuel 6:14 (AMP)

And David was dancing before the LORD with great enthusiasm, and David was wearing a linen ephod [a priest's upper garment].

Nehemiah 8:10 (NLT)

And Nehemiah continued, “Go and celebrate with a feast of rich foods and sweet drinks, and share gifts of food with people who have nothing prepared. This is a sacred day before our Lord. Don’t be dejected and sad, **for the joy of the LORD is your strength!**”

Nehemiah 8:10 (NKJV)

Then he said to them, “Go your way, eat the fat, drink the sweet, and send portions to those for whom nothing is prepared; for *this day is* holy to our Lord. Do not sorrow, **for the joy of the LORD is your strength.**”

Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)

⁹ that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

¹⁰ For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Psalm 103:3-5 (NKJV)

- ³ Who forgives all your iniquities, Who heals all your diseases,
⁴ Who redeems your life from destruction, Who crowns you
with lovingkindness and tender mercies,
⁵ Who satisfies your mouth with good *things*, *So that* your
youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Psalm 100:1 (NKJV)

Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands!

Hebrews 10:24-25 (NKJV)

²⁴ And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, ²⁵ not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

Hebrews 10:24-25 (AMP)

²⁴ and let us consider [thoughtfully] how we may encourage one another to love and to do good deeds, ²⁵ not forsaking our meeting together [as believers for worship and instruction], as is the habit of some, but encouraging *one another*; and all the more [faithfully] as you see the day [of Christ's return] approaching.

Psalm 8:2 (ERV)

From the mouths of children and babies come songs of praise to you. They sing of your power to silence your enemies who were seeking revenge.

Psalm 8:2 (NIV)

Through the praise of children and infants you have established a stronghold against your enemies, to silence the foe and the avenger.

John 3:16 (NLT)

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16 (NKJV)

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

1 John 4:19 (NKJV)

We love Him because He first loved us.

1 John 4:19 (AMP)

We love, because He first loved us.

Matthew 6:33-34 (NIV)

33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NLT)

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart; do not depend

on your own understanding.

6 Seek his will in all you do, and he will show you which path to take.

Proverbs 3:5-6 (NKJV)

5 Trust in the LORD with all your heart, And lean not on your own understanding; **6** In all your ways acknowledge Him, And He shall direct your paths.

Psalm 37:5 (NLT)

Psalm 37:5 (NKJV)

Commit your way to the LORD, Trust also in Him,
And He shall bring *it* to pass.
