2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)



Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

Psalm 37:23-24 (NKJV)

²³ The steps of a *good* man are ordered by the LORD,
And He delights in his way. ²⁴ Though they stumble, they
will never fall, for the LORD holds them by the hand.

Psalm 37:23-24 (AMP)

²³ The steps of a [good and righteous] man are
directed *and* established by the LORD,
And He delights in his way [and blesses his path].
²⁴ When he falls, he will not be hurled down, Because
the LORD is the One who holds his hand *and* sustains
him.

Proverbs 24:16 (NKJV)

For a righteous *man* may fall seven times And rise again, But the wicked shall fall by calamity.

Proverbs 24:16 (AMP)

For a righteous man falls seven times, and rises again, But the wicked stumble in *time of disaster and* collapse.

Proverbs 4:18-19 (NKJV)

18 But the path of the just *is* like the shining sun,
That shines ever brighter unto the perfect day.

19 The way of the wicked *is* like darkness;
They do not know what makes them stumble.

Philippians 4:6-7 (NKJV)

⁶ Be anxious for nothing, but in everything by prayer and supplication, with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God;

⁷ and the peace of God, which surpasses all understanding, will guard your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.

I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Philippians 4:13 (AMP)

¹³ I can do all things [which He has called me to do] through Him who strengthens *and* empowers me [to fulfill His purpose—I am self-sufficient in Christ's sufficiency; I am ready for anything and equal to anything through Him who infuses me with inner strength and confident peace.]

Malachi 3:6a (ERV)

“I am the LORD, and I don’t change.

Malachi 3:6a (NKJV)

“For I *am* the LORD, I do not change;

Malachi 3:6a (AMP)

“For I am the LORD, I do not change [but remain faithful to My covenant with you];

Genesis 22:14 (KJV)

And Abraham called the name of that place Jehovahjireh: as it is said to this day, In the mount of the LORD it shall be seen.

Genesis 22:14 (AMP)

So Abraham named that place The LORD Will Provide. And it is said to this day, “On the mountain of the LORD it will be seen *and* provided.”

Romans 8:32 (NKJV)

He who did not spare His own Son, but delivered Him up for us all, how shall He not with Him also freely give us all things?

Romans 8:32 (AMP)

He who did not spare [even] His own Son, but gave Him up for us all, how will He not also, along with Him, graciously give us all things?

Hebrews 11:17-19 (NLT)

¹⁷ It was by faith that Abraham offered Isaac as a sacrifice when God was testing him. Abraham, who had received God's promises, was ready to sacrifice his only son, Isaac,

¹⁸ even though God had told him, "Isaac is the son through whom your descendants will be counted."

¹⁹ Abraham reasoned that if Isaac died, God was able to bring him back to life again. And in a sense, Abraham did receive his son back from the dead.

Call on Me in the day of trouble; I will rescue you, and you shall honor *and* glorify Me.”

And we know [with great confidence] that God [who is deeply concerned about us] causes all things to work together [as a plan] for good for those who love God, to those who are called according to His plan *and* purpose.
