## **James 4:8 (NLT)**

Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world.

## **James 4:8 (NKJV)**

Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *you* sinners; and purify your hearts, *you* double-minded.

## **Psalm 145:18 (NLT)**

The LORD is close to all who call on him, yes, to all who call on him in truth.

## **Psalm 145:18 (NKJV)**

The LORD *is* near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth.

## **Jeremiah 29:13 (ERV)**

You will search for me, and when you search for me with all your heart, you will find me.

## **Jeremiah 29:13 (NKJV)**

And you will seek Me and find *Me*, when you search for Me with all your heart.

## **Hebrews 10:22 (ERV)**

Sprinkled with the blood of Christ, our hearts have been made free from a guilty conscience, and our bodies have been washed with pure water. So come near to God with a sincere heart, full of confidence because of our faith in Christ.

## **Hebrews 10:22 (NKJV)**

let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience and our bodies washed with pure water.

## **Galatians 6:9 (NLT)**

So let's not get tired of doing what is good. At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing if we don't give up.

## **Galatians 6:9 (NKJV)**

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

## **Matthew 11:28-30 (ERV)**

**28** “Come to me all of you who are tired from the heavy burden you have been forced to carry. I will give you rest.

**29** Accept my teaching. Learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will be able to get some rest.

**30** Yes, the teaching that I ask you to accept is easy. The load I give you to carry is light.”

## **Matthew 11:28-30 (NKJV)**

**28** Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. **29** Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest

for your souls. **30** For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.”

## **1 Peter 5:7-8 (ERV)**

**7 Give all your worries to him**, because he cares for you.

**8 Control yourselves and be careful!** The devil is your enemy, and he goes around like a roaring lion looking for someone to attack and eat.

## **1 Peter 5:7-8 (NKJV)**

**7 casting all your care upon Him**, for He cares for you.

**8 Be sober, be vigilant;** because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour.

## **James 4:7-8 (ERV)**

<sup>7</sup> So give yourselves to God. Stand against the devil, and he will run away from you.

<sup>8</sup> Come Near/Close to God and he will come Near/Close to you. You are sinners, so clean sin out of your lives. You are trying to follow God and the world at the same time. Make your thinking pure.

## **James 4:7-8 (NKJV)**

<sup>7</sup> Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup> Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.

Cleanse your hands, *you* sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.

## **Proverbs 3:30-32 (NLV)**

<sup>30</sup> Do not fight with a man for no reason, when he has done you no wrong. <sup>31</sup> Do not be jealous of a man who hurts others, and do not choose any of his ways. <sup>32</sup> For the bad man is hated by the Lord, but He is near to those who are right with Him.

## **Proverbs 3:30-32 (NKJV)**

<sup>30</sup> Do not strive with a man without cause, If he has done you no harm. <sup>31</sup> Do not envy the oppressor, And choose none of his ways; <sup>32</sup> For the perverse *person is* an abomination to the LORD, But His secret counsel *is* with the upright.

## **Revelation 3:20 (ERV)**

Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in and eat with you. And you will eat with me.

## **Revelation 3:20 (NKJV)**

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

### **Revelation 3:16 (ERV)**

But you are only warm—not hot, not cold. So I am ready to spit you out of my mouth.

### **Revelation 3:16 (NKJV)**

So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

### **Revelation 3:16 (AMP)**

So because you are lukewarm (spiritually useless), and neither hot nor cold, I will vomit you out of My mouth [rejecting you with disgust].

## **Ephesians 5:1-2 (AMP)**

<sup>1</sup> Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father];

<sup>2</sup> and walk *continually* in love [that is, value one another—practice empathy and compassion, unselfishly seeking the best for others], just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God [slain for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.

## Hebrews 13:5-6 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said, “**I will never leave you nor forsake you.**”

<sup>6</sup> So we may boldly say: “The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”

## **2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)**

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

## **2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)**

<sup>7</sup> For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

## **John 3:16 (NLT)**

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

## **John 3:16 (NKJV)**

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

## **Psalm 118:24 (ERV)**

This is the day the LORD has made.

Let us rejoice and be happy today!

## **Psalm 118:24 (NKJV)**

This *is* the day the LORD has made; We will rejoice and be glad in it.

## **John 10:10 (NKJV)**

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

## **John 10:10 (AMP)**

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

## **Philippians 4:6 (NKJV)**

## **Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)**

<sup>9</sup> that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. <sup>10</sup> For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

## **Hebrews 13:8 (NKJV)**

Jesus Christ *is* the same yesterday, today, and forever.

## **Hebrews 13:8 (AMP)**

Jesus Christ is [eternally changeless, always] the same yesterday and today and forever.
