## **Philippians 3:13-14 (NLT)**

<sup>13</sup> No, dear brothers and sisters, I have not achieved it, but I focus on this one thing: Forgetting the past and looking forward to what lies ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press on to reach the end of the race and receive the heavenly prize for which God, through Christ Jesus, is calling us.

## **Philippians 3:13-14 (NKJV)**

<sup>13</sup> Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended; but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind and reaching forward to those things which are ahead, <sup>14</sup> I press toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus.

## **James 4:7 (NKJV)**

7 Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you.

## **James 4:7 (AMP)**

7 So submit to [the authority of] God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him] and he will flee from you.

## **James 4:8 (NKJV)**

**Draw near to God and He will draw near to you.**

**Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.**

## **James 4:8 (AMP)**

**Come close to God [with a contrite heart] and He will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; and purify your [unfaithful] hearts, you double-minded [people].**

## **2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)**

For God has not given us a spirit of fear,  
but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

## **2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)**

<sup>7</sup> For God did not give us a spirit of timidity or  
cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit]  
of power and of love and of sound judgment and  
personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm,  
well-balanced mind and self-control].

## **Galatians 6:9 (NLT)**

So let's not get tired of doing what is good.  
At just the right time we will reap a harvest of blessing  
if we don't give up.

## **Galatians 6:9 (NKJV)**

And let us not grow weary while doing good, for in due  
season we shall reap if we do not lose heart.

## **Galatians 6:9 (AMP)**

Let us not grow weary *or* become discouraged in doing  
good, for at the proper time we will reap, if we do not  
give in.

## **Matthew 11:28-30 (ERV)**

<sup>28</sup> Come to me all of you who are tired from the heavy burden you have been forced to carry. I will give you rest.

<sup>29</sup> Accept my teaching. Learn from me. I am gentle and humble in spirit. And you will be able to get some rest.

<sup>30</sup> Yes, the teaching that I ask you to accept is easy. The load I give you to carry is light.

## **Matthew 11:28-30 (NKJV)**

<sup>28</sup> Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. <sup>29</sup> Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest

for your souls. <sup>30</sup> For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.”

## **1 Peter 5:7-8 (NKJV)**

<sup>7</sup> casting all your care upon Him, for He cares for you.

<sup>8</sup> Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil walks about like a roaring lion, seeking whom he may devour

## **1 Peter 5:7-8 (AMP)**

<sup>7</sup> casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully]. <sup>8</sup> Be sober [well balanced and self-disciplined], be alert *and* cautious at all times. That enemy of yours, the devil, prowls around like a roaring lion [fiercely hungry], seeking someone to devour.

## **John 10:10 (NKJV)**

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have *it* more abundantly.

## **John 10:10 (AMP)**

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have *and* enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

## **James 4:7-8 (NKJV)**

<sup>7</sup> Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup> Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *you* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *you* double-minded.

## **James 4:7-8 (AMP)**

<sup>7</sup> So submit to [the authority of] God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him] and he will flee from you. <sup>8</sup> Come close to God [with a contrite heart] and He will come close to you. Wash your hands, *you* sinners; and purify your [unfaithful] hearts, *you* double-minded [people].

## **Isaiah 40:31 (KJV)**

But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint.

## **Isaiah 40:31 (AMP)**

But those who wait for the LORD [who expect, look for, and hope in Him] Will gain new strength *and* renew their power; They will lift up their wings [and rise up close to God] like eagles [rising toward the sun]; They will run and not become weary, They will walk and not grow tired.

## **James 1:8 (NLT)**

Their loyalty is divided between God and the world, and they are unstable in everything they do.

## **James 1:8 (NKJV)**

He is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.

## **James 1:8 (AMP)**

*Being* a double-minded man, unstable *and* restless in all his ways [in everything he thinks, feels, or decides].

## Hebrews 10:23-25 (NLT)

<sup>23</sup> Let us hold tightly without wavering to the hope we affirm, for God can be trusted to keep his promise. <sup>24</sup> Let us think of ways to motivate one another to acts of love and good works. <sup>25</sup> And let us not neglect our meeting together, as some people do, but encourage one another, especially now that the day of his return is drawing near.

## Hebrews 10:23-25 (NKJV)

<sup>23</sup> Let us hold fast the confession of *our* hope without wavering, for He who promised *is* faithful. <sup>24</sup> And let us consider one another in order to stir up love and good works, <sup>25</sup> not forsaking the assembling of ourselves together, as *is* the manner of some, but exhorting *one another*, and so much the more as you see the Day approaching.

## **Revelation 3:16 (GNT)**

But because you are lukewarm, neither hot nor cold, I am going to spit you out of my mouth!

## **Revelation 3:16 (NKJV)**

So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

## **Revelation 3:20 (ERV)**

Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If you hear my voice and open the door, I will come in and eat with you. And you will eat with me.

## **Revelation 3:20 (NKJV)**

Behold, I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.

## Hebrews 13:5-6 (NKJV)

<sup>5</sup> Let your conduct be without covetousness; be content with such things as you have. For He Himself has said,

**“I will never leave you nor forsake you.”**

<sup>6</sup> So we may boldly say: “The LORD is my helper; I will not fear. What can man do to me?”

## **Ephesians 5:1-2 (AMP)**

**<sup>1</sup>Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father]; <sup>2</sup>and walk *continually* in love [that is, value one another—practice empathy and compassion, unselfishly seeking the best for others], just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God [slain for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.**

## **Acts 6:4 (NKJV)**

but we will give ourselves continually to prayer and to the ministry of the word.”

## **Acts 6:4 (AMP)**

But we will [continue to] devote ourselves [steadfastly] to prayer and to the ministry of the word.

## **Matthew 24:12-14 (ERV)**

<sup>12</sup> There will be so much more evil in the world that the love of most believers will grow cold. <sup>13</sup> But the one who remains faithful to the end will be saved. <sup>14</sup> And the Good News I have shared about God's kingdom will be told throughout the world. It will be spread to every nation. Then the end will come.

## **Matthew 24:12-14 (NKJV)**

<sup>12</sup> And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold. <sup>13</sup> But he who endures to the end shall be saved. <sup>14</sup> And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in all the world as a witness to all the nations, and then the end will come.

## **2 Chronicles 7:14 (NKJV)**

If My people who are called by My name will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

## **Romans 10:9-10 (NKJV)**

**9** That if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.

## **John 14:6 (NKJV)**

## **John 14:6 (AMP)**

Jesus said to him, “I am the [only] Way [to God] and the [real] Truth and the [real] Life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

## **John 10:9 (NKJV)**

I am the door. If anyone enters by Me, he will be saved, and will go in and out and find pasture.

## **John 10:9 (AMP)**

I am the Door; anyone who enters through Me will be saved [and will live forever], and will go in and out [freely], and find pasture (spiritual security).

## **Psalm 145:18 (NLT)**

The LORD is close to all who call on him, yes, to all who call on him in truth.

## **Psalm 145:18 (NKJV)**

The LORD *is* near to all who call upon Him, To all who call upon Him in truth.

## **Philippians 3:13-14 (NKJV)**

<sup>13</sup> Brethren, I do not count myself to have apprehended;  
but one thing *I do*, forgetting those things which are behind
