John 10:27 (NKJV)

My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me.

John 10:27 (AMP)

The sheep that are My own hear My voice *and* listen to Me; I know them, and they follow Me.

Psalm 23 (KJV)

1 The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.

2 He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.

3 He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.

4 Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou art with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.

5 Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.

6 Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD for ever.

Colossians 2:6 (NKJV)

As you therefore have received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk in Him

Colossians 2:6 (AMP)

Therefore as you have received Christ Jesus the Lord, walk in [union with] Him [reflecting His character in the things you do and say—living lives that lead others away from sin]

1 John 2:6 (NKJV)

He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.

1 John 2:6 (AMP)

whoever says he lives in Christ [that is, whoever says he has accepted Him as God and Savior] ought [as a moral obligation] to walk *and* conduct himself just as He walked *and* conducted Himself.

Luke 9:23 (ERV)

Jesus continued to say to all of them, “Any of you who want to be my follower must stop thinking about yourself and what you want. You must be willing to carry the cross that is given to you every day for following me.

Luke 9:23 (NKJV)

Then He said to *them* all, “If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me.

Micah 6:8 (NKJV)

He has shown you, O man, what *is* good; And what does the LORD require of you But to do justly, To love mercy, And to walk humbly with your God?

Micah 6:8 (AMP)

He has told you, O man, what is good; And what does the LORD require of you Except to be just, and to love [and to diligently practice] kindness (compassion), And to walk humbly with your God [setting aside any overblown sense of importance or self-righteousness]?

Amos 3:3 (ERV)

Two people will not walk together unless they have agreed to do so.

Amos 3:3 (NKJV)

Can two walk together, unless they are agreed?

Ephesians 5:1-2 (AMP)

¹Therefore become imitators of God [copy Him and follow His example], as well-beloved children [imitate their father];

² and walk *continually* in love [that is, value one another—practice empathy and compassion, unselfishly seeking the best for others], just as Christ also loved you and gave Himself up for us, an offering and sacrifice to God [slain for you, so that it became] a sweet fragrance.

2 Timothy 1:6 (NKJV)

Therefore I remind you to **STIR UP the gift of God which is in you** through the laying on of my hands.

2 Timothy 1:6 (AMP)

That is why I would remind you to stir up (rekindle the embers of, fan the flame of, and keep burning) the [gracious] gift of God, [the inner fire] that is in you by means of the laying on of my hands [with those of the elders at your ordination].

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

2 Timothy 1:7 (AMP)

⁷ For God did not give us a spirit of timidity *or* cowardice *or* fear, but [He has given us a spirit] of power and of love and of sound judgment *and* personal discipline [abilities that result in a calm, well-balanced mind and self-control].

John 7:37-38 (KJV)

³⁷ In the last day, that great day of the feast, Jesus stood and cried, saying, If any man thirst, let him come unto me, and drink.

³⁸ He that believeth on me, as the scripture hath said, out of his belly shall flow rivers of living water.

James 4:7-8 (NKJV)

⁷ Therefore submit to God. Resist the devil and he will flee from you. ⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse *your* hands, *you* sinners; and purify *your* hearts, *you* double-minded.

James 4:7-8 (AMP)

⁷ So submit to [the authority of] God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him] and he will flee from you. ⁸ Come close to God [with a contrite heart] and He will come close to you. Wash your hands, *you* sinners; and purify your [unfaithful] hearts, *you* double-minded [people].

John 3:16 (NLT)

For this is how God loved the world: He gave his one and only Son, so that everyone who believes in him will not perish but have eternal life.

John 3:16 (NKJV)

For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.

1 Peter 5:7 (NKJV)

Casting all your care upon him; for he careth for you.

1 Peter 5:7 (AMP)

Casting all your cares [all your anxieties, all your worries, and all your concerns, once and for all] on Him, for He cares about you [with deepest affection, and watches over you very carefully].

John 10:10 (NKJV)

The thief does not come except to steal, and to kill, and to destroy. I have come that they may have life, and that they may have it more abundantly.

John 10:10 (AMP)

The thief comes only in order to steal and kill and destroy. I came that they may have and enjoy life, and have it in abundance [to the full, till it overflows].

Jeremiah 2:13 (NKJV)

For My people have committed two evils: They have forsaken Me, the fountain of living waters, *And* hewn themselves cisterns—broken/cracked cisterns that can hold no water.

Jeremiah 2:13 (AMP)

For My people have committed two evils: They have abandoned (rejected) Me, The fountain of living water, And they have carved out their own cisterns, Broken/Cracked cisterns That cannot hold water.

Proverbs 18:21 (NKJV)

Death and life *are* in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.

Proverbs 18:21 (AMP)

Death and life are in the power of the tongue,
And those who love it *and* indulge it will eat its fruit *and* bear the consequences of their words.

Matthew 12:37 (NKJV)

For by your words you will be justified, and by your words you will be condemned.

Matthew 12:37 (AMP)

For by your words [reflecting your spiritual condition] you will be justified *and* acquitted of the guilt of sin; and by your words [rejecting Me] you will be condemned *and* sentenced.

Romans 12:2 (NLT)

Don't copy the behavior and customs of this world, but let God transform you into a new person by changing the way you think. Then you will learn to know God's will for you, which is good and pleasing and perfect.

Romans 12:2 (NKJV)

And do not be conformed to this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what *is* that good and acceptable and perfect will of God.

Isaiah 64:8 (NKJV)

But now, O LORD, You *are* our Father;
We *are* the clay, and You our potter;
And all we *are* the work of Your hand.

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NLT)

This means that anyone who belongs to Christ has become a new person. The old life is gone; a new life has begun!

2 Corinthians 5:17 (NKJV)

Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, *he is* a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new.

Revelation 3:16 (NLT)

But since you are like lukewarm water, neither hot nor cold, I will spit you out of my mouth!

Revelation 3:16 (NKJV)

So then, because you are lukewarm, and neither cold nor hot, I will vomit you out of My mouth.

Genesis 5:24 (NLT)

Enoch walking in close fellowship with God.
Then one day he disappeared, because God took him.

Genesis 5:24 (NKJV)

And Enoch walked with God; and he *was* not, for God took him.

Genesis 5:24 (AMP)

And [in reverent fear and obedience] Enoch walked with God; and he was not [found among men], because God took him [away to be home with Him].

Genesis 6:9 (NLT)

This is the account of Noah and his family. Noah was a righteous man, the only blameless person living on earth at the time, and he walked in close fellowship with God.

Genesis 6:9 (NKJV) Noah Pleases God

This is the genealogy of Noah. Noah was a just man, perfect in his generations. Noah walked with God.

Jeremiah 7:23 (NKJV)

But this is what I commanded them, saying, 'Obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people. And walk in all the ways that I have commanded you, that it may be well with you.'

Jeremiah 7:23 (AMP)

But this thing I did command them: 'Listen to *and* obey My voice, and I will be your God, and you shall be My people; and you will walk in all the way which I command you, so that it may be well with you.'

2 Timothy 1:7 (NKJV)

For God has not given us a spirit of fear, but of power and of love and of a sound mind.

1 John 4:4 (NKJV)

You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world.
